

This Sunday's Gospel invites us to continue our reflection on the person and mission of John the Baptist. Today we depart from the Gospel of Mark and read a selection from the Gospel of John.

The Gospel for today combines a brief passage from the prologue to John's Gospel with a report about John the Baptist. As in Mark's Gospel, the Gospel of John contains no birth narrative. Instead, John's Gospel begins with a theological reflection that has come to be called the "prologue." This prologue places the story of Jesus in its cosmological framework. It speaks of Jesus' existence with God since the beginning of time. In John's Gospel, Jesus is presented as the fulfillment of the Old Testament and the culmination of the Word, the light that is coming into the world's darkness.

Following this prologue, John reports on the ministry of John the Baptist. We learn about the attention that John the Baptist received from the Jewish authorities. Messengers from the Jewish priests, the Levites and the Pharisees question John about his identity and the meaning of the baptisms that he is performing. John's Gospel uses these questions to establish the relationship between Jesus and John the Baptist. John the Baptist is not the Messiah, nor is he Elijah or the Prophet. In John's denials, we hear echoes of the kind of messianic expectations that were common in first-century Palestine.

The only affirmative response that John the Baptist gives is when he quotes the prophet Isaiah. Upon answering the next question, John announces that the savior they seek is already among them, but as yet unrecognized. John's response highlights for us an important Advent theme: Jesus has already come into the world as our savior. During Advent, we pray that we will be able to recognize Jesus' presence in our midst. Advent also reminds us that Jesus will come again to fulfill the promise of salvation. We pray that we will continue to be watchful as we anticipate that great day.

The third Sunday of Advent is also called *Gaudete Sunday*. *Gaudete*, a Latin word which means "rejoice," is taken from the entrance antiphon for Sunday's Mass. This theme is echoed in today's second reading from the first Letter to the Thessalonians. It is a reminder that Advent is a season of joy because our salvation is already at hand.

Ewangelia dzisiejszej niedzieli zaprasza nas do kontynuowania refleksji nad osobą i misją Jana Chrzciciela. Dziś odchodzimy od Ewangelii Św. Marka i czytamy fragment Ewangelii Św. Jana.

Dzisiejsza Ewangelia łączy krótki fragment prologu do Ewangelii Św. Jana z relacją o Janie Chrzcicielu. Podobnie jak Ewangelia Św. Marka, Ewangelia Św. Jana nie zawiera narracji o narodzinach. Ewangelia Św. Jana rozpoczyna się refleksją teologiczną, którą zaczęto nazywać "prologiem". Prolog ten umieszcza historię Jezusa w kosmologicznych ramach. Mówi o istnieniu Jezusa z Bogiem od początku czasu. W Ewangelii Św. Jana Jezus jest przedstawiony jako wypełnienie Starego Testamentu i kulminacja Słowa, światła, które przychodzi do ciemności świata.

Po tym prologu Św. Jan relacjonuje posługę Jana Chrzciciela. Dowiadujemy się o uwadze, jaką Jan Chrzciciel otrzymał od władz żydowskich. Posłańcy żydowskich kapłanów, lewitów i faryzeuszy pytają Jana o jego tożsamość i znaczenie chrztu, którego dokonuje. Ewangelia Św. Jana wykorzystuje te pytania do ustalenia relacji między Jezusem a Janem Chrzcicielem. Jan Chrzciciel nie jest Mesjaszem, ani Eliaszem czy Prorokiem. W zaprzeczeniach Jana słyszymy echa oczekiwań mesjańskich, które były powszechne w Palestynie pierwszego wieku.

Jedyną twierdzącą odpowiedzią Jana Chrzciciela jest cytat z proroka Izajasza.

Odpowiadając na kolejne pytanie, Jan ogłasza, że Zbawiciel, którego szukają, jest już wśród nich, ale jeszcze nierozpoznany. Odpowiedź Jana podkreśla dla nas ważny temat Adwentu: Jezus już przyszedł na świat jako nasz Zbawiciel. Podczas Adwentu modlimy się, abyśmy byli w stanie rozpoznać obecność Jezusa pośród nas. Adwent przypomina nam również, że Jezus przyjdzie ponownie, aby wypełnić obietnicę zbawienia. Modlimy się, abyśmy nadal czuwali, oczekując tego wielkiego dnia.

Trzecia niedziela Adwentu jest również nazywana Niedzielą Gaudete. Gaudete, łacińskie słowo, które oznacza "radujcie się", pochodzi z antyfony na wejście niedzielnej Mszy Świętej. Temat ten powtarza się w dzisiejszym drugim czytaniu z Pierwszego Listu do Tesaloniczan. Jest to przypomnienie, że Adwent jest okresem radości, ponieważ nasze zbawienie jest już w zasięgu ręki.





Last Sunday, December 10th we celebrated the beginning of the second week of Advent – the week of PEACE.

During the 11:00 a.m. Family Youth Mass celebrated by our pastor, Fr. Greg Wojcik, we had the opportunity to witness a great event - **the Rite of Enrollment for the Confirmation Candidates** from our Religious Education Program and St. Alphonsus School.

What is the Rite of Enrollment for Confirmation?

The Rite of Enrollment is a ceremony in which the Candidates make their official commitment to enter into preparations for the Sacrament of Confirmation. It is also a sign to the larger community that all of us have a role in the formation of anyone in the parish. Likewise, it shows candidates and their families that they are part of the larger faith community.



Prior to the Rite of Enrollment our Confirmation Candidates were asked to seriously and prayerfully think about what will be required of them during this time of preparation.

During the ceremony, after the homily, the candidates were called by name to come to the altar, and a dialogue began between our pastor, Fr. Greg, and the candidates, after which they were asked to read together the commitments they had made in preparation for receiving the sacrament of Confirmation. After reading their commitments, Fr. Greg, collected the signed contract from each candidate. All the candidates returned to their seats and the Liturgy of the Eucharist began.

After Mass, everyone was invited to come to school gym and taste delicious pancakes and have their picture taken with Santa.






