

THE FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD / CANDLEMAS DAY / FEB 2

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord is a reference to the Gospel account of the offering of Jesus. 40 days after His birth, Mary and Joseph carried the baby to the temple in Jerusalem to offer Him to God in accordance with the law of Moses as a tribute of thanksgiving for the gift of life to the Israelites during the passage of the Angel of Destruction through Egypt. Think about your own "presentation" at your Baptism. The Paschal Candle, which is first lit at the Easter Vigil is the preeminent "Light of Christ" in liturgy, is lit at your Baptism. From that light is lit a smaller baptismal candle. This connection is not lost on the Church. Since the seventh century, candles have been blessed on February 2nd, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This is where we get the name "Candlemas." This feast closes the Christmas cycle. In churches on this day the manger is dismantled, in homes christmas trees are put away, the singing of carols stops.

In the Church, this day is also commemorated as "Our Lady of the Thunder Candle" day. The legend, captured in first image, shows snow-covered homes in dim light. The people inside their homes are afraid of the hungry wolves on rampage outside the poor village. The legend relates that Mary, the Mother of God of the "Blessed Thunder Candle," watches over the people on cold February nights. With her thunder candle she wards off the ravenous pack and protects the peasants from all harm. While wolves are typically no longer a threat, Catholics still light the candles during thunderstorms, during times of prayer, or by the dying. <u>Candles will be blessed during all Masses on February 2/3/4.</u> Please bring your own candles. Limited amount of candles will be available for purchase on the weekend of January 28th and February 4th at \$10 each. Candles for this occasion are thicker and taller than the usual taper candles, and they are decorated with ribbons and images of Mary.

ŚWIĘTO OFIAROWANIA PAŃSKIEGO / MATKI BOSKIEJ GROMNICZNEJ

Święto Ofiarowania Pańskiego nawiązuje do ewangelicznego opisu ofiarowania Jezusa. 40 dni po Jego narodzinach Maryja i Józef zanieśli Dzieciątko do świątyni w Jerozolimie, aby ofiarować Je Bogu zgodnie z prawem Mojżesza, jako hołd dziękczynny za dar życia dla Izraelitów podczas przejścia Anioła Zniszczenia przez Egipt. Pomyślmy o swojej własnej "prezentacji" podczas Chrztu Św. Świeca Paschalna, która po raz pierwszy zapalana jest podczas Wigilii Paschalnej, jest najważniejszym "Światłem Chrystusa" w liturgii. Od tego światła zapalana jest mniejsza świeca chrzcielna. Kościół nie zapomina o tym związku. Od VII wieku świece są błogosławione 2 lutego, w święto Ofiarowania Pańskiego. Święto to zamyka okres Bożego Narodzenia. W kościołach tego dnia demontuje się żłóbek, w domach chowa się choinki, zaprzestaje się śpiewania kolęd.

W Kościele 2-gi luty obchodzony jest również jako święto Matki Boskiej Gromnicznej. Legenda, uchwycona w pierwszym obrazie, przedstawia pokryte śniegiem domy ledwo co oświetlone. Ludzie w domach boją się głodnych wilków grasujących na zewnątrz biednej wioski. Legenda głosi, że Maryja, Matka Boża "Błogosławionej Świecy Gromnicznej", czuwa nad ludźmi w zimne lutowe noce. Swoją świecą odstrasza wygłodniałe wilki i chroni ludzi przed wszelką krzywdą. Chociaż wilki zazwyczaj nie stanowią już zagrożenia, katolicy nadal zapalają świece podczas burzy, w czasie modlitwy lub przy umierających. <u>Gromnice będą święcone podczas wszystkich Mszy Św. 2-3-4 lutego</u>. Prosimy przynieść swoje gromnice. Ograniczona ilość nowych gromnic, w cenie \$10, będzie dostępna przed Mszami Św. w weekend 28-go stycznia i 4-go lutego.

This Weekend's Gospel: Mark 1:21-28

When they came to Capernaum, and on the sabbath Jesus entered the synagogue and taught. The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one having authority and not as the scribes. In their synagogue was a man with an unclean spirit; he cried out, "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!" For example: if you would like 4 gift cards to Jewel at \$25 each, fill out the form and turn it in with a payment of \$100. On the form you will see that MANNA pays us 4% for your order. Your gift cards for a total value of \$100 will be waiting for you on the weekend of February 11th in the sacristy. Gift cards are then used at Jewel just like cash. The parish gets a cash donation of \$4 from MANNA for your order.

Gift cards purchased through this program come to us directly from the company—they are shipped via UPS—omitting the chance of being tampered with.
