

This Weekend's Gospel: John 3:14-21

Jesus said to Nicodemus: "Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. LENTEN EVENT - PROCESSION OF THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS

We invite everyone to join us on Friday, March 15th for the STATIONS OF THE CROSS PROCESSION on the campus of St. Thomas Becket Church.

On that day, our Lenten prayerful event will begin at St. Thomas Becket Church with a <u>bilingual Mass at 6:00 pm.</u>
At approximately 6:45 pm, in the light of flaming candles, we will depart for the Stations of the Cross outside the church.

The route of the Stations of the Cross will follow the sidewalk around the field next to St. Thomas Becket Church. The First Station will be outside the church and will start in front of the church entrance. The last - Fourteenth Station will be inside the church.

We need a group of people who will carry the cross. We need groups of men and women, fathers and mothers, groups of teenagers, teachers, catechists, and people from all parish ministry groups.

During the Stations of the Cross, a cross will be carried from Station to Station by different groups of people and from shoulder to shoulder will be passed on to other groups, to people who are willing to carry it. The cross, which is about eight feet long, will be carried horizontally, and at each Station, when everyone stops, it will be placed vertically.

We ask everyone to bring a candle or lamp with them. Those who would like to join us in reading the meditations for each Station, please contact me so that I can provide you with the content of the meditations in advance.

After the Stations of the Cross, we invite everyone to the Hall Room for hot chocolate and tea. Please come and join us for this special evening. **God bless!**

WIELKOPOSTNE WYDARZENIE - PROCESJA DROGI KRZYZOWEJ

Zapraszamy wszystkich na pierwszą w naszej parafii PROCESJE DROGI KRZYŻOWEJ, która odbędzie się wpiątek, 15 marca na kampusie kościoła Św. Tomasza Becketa.

Tego dnia nasza pielgrzymka rozpocznie się w kościele św. Tomasza Becketa dwujęzyczna Msza Święta o godzinie 6:00 pm.

Około godziny 6:45 pm, w świetle płonących świec, wyruszymy na Drogę Krzyżową na zewnątrz kościoła. Trasa Drogi Krzyżowej będzie przebiegać chodnikiem wokół parku/ boiska obok kościoła św. Tomasza Becketa.

Podczas Drogi Krzyżowej, krzyż będzie niesiony od Stacji do Stacji przez różne grupy ludzi i z ramion na ramiona będzie przekazywany innym osobom, które będą chciały go ponieść. Krzyż, który ma około ośmiu stóp długości, będzie niesiony poziomo, a przy każdej stacji, gdy wszyscy się zatrzymają, zostanie podniesiony pionowo.

Prosimy wszystkich o przyniesienie ze sobą świecy lub lampki. Osoby, które chciałyby przyłączyć się do czytania rozważań do każdej stacji, proszę o kontakt ze mną, abym mógła wcześniej przekazać treść rozważań.
